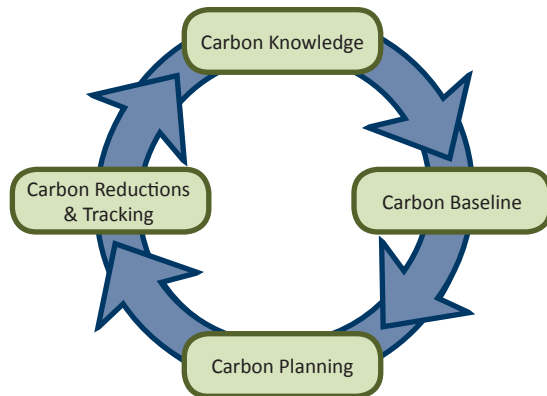

Reducing Your Organization's Carbon Footprint

Addressing climate change requires participation at every level of society, including the non-profit sector. Every non-profit organization's operations have a carbon footprint: air and ground travel, heating and cooling offices, powering equipment, paper use, shipping, and waste disposal, to name a few.

4 Steps to Energy Sustainability



1 Develop carbon consciousness

2 Perform a carbon baseline audit

To cut emissions you need to know your baseline: your organization's current emissions. SSG is an independent, third party certified carbon auditor that uses internationally recognized standards (ISO 14064 and the GHG Protocol Initiative) and specialized software to create accurate emissions assessments. The software can track ongoing emissions to compare them to the baseline, providing an ongoing audit.

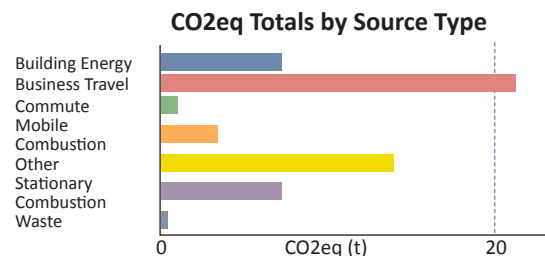
Outcomes: An audited report with a third party assessment of your carbon emissions; a new form of accountability to stakeholders and the public.



3 Plan for carbon sustainability

SSG analyzes your carbon emissions audit and works with you to develop policies and plans with timelines and milestones for sustainable energy use across your organization. We identify short, medium and long term actions, as well as the amount of relative effort, funding and payback involved.

Outcomes: The ability to measure and manage carbon emissions in-house; an organizational strategy to reduce emissions; a financial analysis of the emissions reduction plan.



An SSG carbon emissions report provides you with detailed and summary information about your organization's carbon footprint.

4 Carbon reduction tools & tracking

SSG works with you to implement emissions reduction actions based on the specific nature of your organizational operations, starting with the relatively easy "low hanging fruit" actions.
